# Keynote Speaker 1

#### Hotaka MACHIDA:

Senior research fellow, the Panasonic Research Institute, Ltd.

Mr. Machida is also a visiting senior research fellow in the Institute of Geoeconomics at the International House of Japan. Before joining the private sector in November 2022, he was a Japanese career diplomat focusing on Japan-China relations from 2001 to 2022. He studied at Nanjing University in China and Harvard University in the United States before working as Second Secretary at the Embassy of Japan in China from 2006-2008. He was later posted in the China-Mongolia division and the Status of Forces Agreement division in the North American Affairs Bureau in the Ministry. He was a counsellor in the Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations (2017-2020) and the Embassy of Japan in China (2020-2022). He holds an M.A. from the Graduate School of Arts and Science at Harvard University and a bachelor's degree from the Faculty of Law at the University of Tokyo.

#### **Michito TSURUOKA:**

Associate Professor, Faculty of Policy Management, Keio University / Visiting Fellow in the Strategic and Defence Studies Centre, Australian National University

Dr. Tsuruoka studied political science and international relations at Keio University and Georgetown University and received a Ph.D. in War Studies from King's College London. He served as an advisor for NATO at the Embassy of Japan in Belgium and a senior research fellow at the National Institute for Defense Studies before assuming the current position at Keio in 2017. He specializes in contemporary European politics and international security.

In English, his recent articles appears on China International Strategy Review, Contemporary Politics, and Journal of Contemporary China. He sits on government panels including Council on the Actual State of Land Use, Advisory Panel on Science & Technology Diplomacy, and Expert Panel on 50th Year of Japan-ASEAN Friendship and Cooperation. He also works as Faculty Fellow, Research Institute of Economy, Trade, and Industry; Visiting Fellow, 21st Century Policy Institute, Keidanren; Research Fellow of Japan Center for International Exchange. He has served as a visiting scholar at Georgetown University, Seoul National University, Stanford University and Wilson Center. He received his B.A. from International Christian University and his Ph.D. from the Graduate Schools for Law and Politics at the University of Tokyo.
