He holds doctorates in Politics (Oxford) and Social Anthropology (Oslo) and was Professor of Russian Studies at Oslo University and Montague Burton Professor of International Relations at the London School of Economics. His research agenda broadly centers on the emergence and development of the sovereign state, covering state formation, resource politics, and historical international relations, mainly focusing on East/Southeast Asia and the Middle East.
